Dear Parents/Guardians,

Change in Hybrid Schedule Coming November 2!- Beginning November 2, 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th grades will be in the building for learning Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Friday. PreK will remain in the building daily and grades 5th -8th will remain in the building two days a week with Elearning three days a week. This will remain in place until we have different direction from the Marion County Health Department or the Mayor's Office. In the event of an increase in COVID cases, we may need to revert back to the original hybrid. We will always give you as much notice as possible.

No School Reminder! -Remember school will be closed this Friday the 23rd and Monday the 26th for Fall Break.

Outerwear- With the change in weather approaching, please be sure your child(ren) have the proper coats, hats and gloves. Due to COVID guidelines, we will continue to dismiss outside whenever possible.

Car riders- Walkers should not be going to vehicles parked down the street. If your child leaves by car, please be sure to pick them up in the lot across from the school. Thank you for helping to keep our students and staff safe.

Symptoms for Students- Please monitor your children for these symptoms and keep them home if these are displayed.

- Fever, 100 degrees or higher
- new, uncontrolled cough
- New onset of severe headache (usually with the fever)
- Diarrhea (more than usual)

Please do not give your child(ren) fever reducing medication before sending them to school. As always, whether the learning is remote or in person a call to the office should be made if a child is sick.

Quarantining- If a family member has been out of the country, students must quarantine for two weeks after his/her return. Please contact the school office.
