**Lent Begins!**- Today is Ash Wednesday, which signifies the beginning of the season of Lent. The students received ashes during Mass. Our eighth graders will be leading Stations of the Cross on Fridays at 2:15 p.m. in the church. Parents are always welcome to join us in Mass or at Stations of the Cross. The parish calendar is included with this newsletter. It is important that your child(ren) not just learn about their faith during school hours, but that you as a family attend Mass as well on the weekends. Students will be focusing upon the three areas of: prayer, fasting and giving. Each family can make your own decisions about giving up any food items. General guidance is that this applies to ages over fourteen. However, maybe the younger students can watch less t.v., play less video games, etc. The students in 2<sup>nd</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade also participated in the sacrament of Reconciliation today following Mass.

**Rice Bowls-** One way that children may encounter Lent, is through participation in our Catholic Relief Services Rice Bowls. Students will be learning about these countries: Guatemala, Uganda, Sri Lanka and Sierre Leone. Students will watch videos which describe how children and families in other countries live and some of the struggles they face. They come to understand how their individual/family donations can help others in need. Please encourage your child to complete small chores at home to earn money to give to others. We will be collecting donations each week of Lent.
