The second packet is ready for pickup in the office between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 5:30 p.m. on Monday, April 6th and Wednesday, April 8th. This work is intended for the time period of April 6th-17th. We will be open on Mondays and Wednesdays for those wishing to pick up breakfast between the hours of 7:30 a.m.- 9:30 a.m. and lunch between 11:30 a.m.-1:30 p.m. These meals are free for students under the age of eighteen and \$2 a meal for adults. Packets could also be picked up during these times. Teachers are reaching out to parents through e-mail and/or Class DoJo or using Google classroom to support your students. We are working to connect and increase learning during the time away from school in difference ways and appreciate your patience as we work through those supports.
